Chains of Narration: Aisha's Age of Nine

(2) "The Messenger of God consummated his marriage with me in my house when I was nine years old." 3 Aisha → Yaḥya bin 'Abd Al-Raḥmān bin Ḥātib → Muḥammad bin 'Amr → Yaḥya bin Sa'īd Al-Umawī → Sa'īd, his son

(3) "...he consummated his marriage with her after coming to Medina when she was nine years old." 3 Aisha → 'Urwah (ibn Zubayr) → Hishām bin 'Urwah → Abān Al-'Aţţar → 'Abd Al-Wārith → 'Abd Al-Şamad (father of 'Abd Al-Wārith) → 'Ali bin Naşr

> (4) "...and consummated the marriage when she was nine years old." 3 Aisha → Muḥammad, father of Ḥishām → Ḥishām bin Muḥammad → Ibn Sa'ad → Al-Ḥārith

(5) "On the day he consummated the marriage with her she was nine years old." 4 Aisha → 'Amrah bint 'Abd Al-Raḥmān bin Sa'd → Rayṭah → Mūsā bin Muḥammad bin 'Abd Al-Raḥmān → Ibn 'Umar Al-Wāqidī

Unwah ibn Zubayr was one of the leading fuqaha (Islamic legal scholars) of Medina. His son, Hisham, was grandson of Aisha's half-sister.
