

تَنَفَّسَتْ = tanaffasat,

1<sup>st</sup> pers. sing. past form of tanaffas:  
inhaled / breathed / gasped.

Not to be confused with the  
etymologically related but completely  
separate item of vocabulary

نَفِيسَتْ = nafisat,

3<sup>rd</sup> pers. fem. sing. of نَفَس = nafas  
which has been translated as menstruate  
on the basis of  
نَفْس = nafsun,  
a rare word for blood.

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
