

Notes for references on the poster comparing Hamas and Muhammad's men

Green text indicates direct quotes from Muslim texts.

Muwatta Malik, Book 43, Hadith 1596: says that **There is no punishment of a free man for any injury of a slave, and that The free man is not killed for the slave, even if he murders him.** Al-Bukhari declared Muwatta Malik to be the most sahih book on earth.

Killing:

Sahih Muslim 1745a: **the Prophet of God, when asked about the women and children of the mushrikin [disbelievers] being killed during the night raid, said: They are from them.** Also Sahih Muslim 1745b **Messenger of Allah, we kill the children of the mushrikin [disbelievers] during the night raids. He [Muhammad] said: They are from them.**

Sahih Al-Bukhari 4200 and Sahih Al-Bukhari 3804 (in *Slavery* section below) discuss two cases of killing enemy fighters; A better hadith for killing might be, for example, Sunan Abi Dawud 4404 (is sahih): **I was among the male prisoners from the Banu Qurayza. They examined us, and those who had begun to grow pubic hair were killed, and those who had not were not killed.** See also the 2 torture-deaths in the *Torture* section below: Kinana and Umm Qirfah.

Reliance of the Traveller – Chapter on the Rules of War – says: **It is permitted to kill old men and monks.**

Slavery:

Quran 23:1-6 says that men can have sex with wives or slaves

Sahih Al-Bukhari 5204 **The Prophet (ﷺ) said, "None of you should flog his wife as he flogs a slave and then have sexual intercourse with her in the last part of the day."**

Sahih Al-Bukhari 4200 **The Prophet (ﷺ) had their warriors killed, their offspring and woman taken as captives. captives = enslaved. These slaves included Safiya.**

Sahih Al-Bukhari 3804 **Sa'ad said: "I judge that the fighting men should be killed and their families enslaved." He (Muhammad) said: "You have given the judgement of God, the judgement of a king."**

Sahih Al-Bukhari 2594 **One of Muhammad's many wives freed a slave-girl, but Muhammad responded: You would have got more reward if you had given the slave-girl to one of your uncles.**

Extra: Reliance of the Traveller – Chapter on the Rules of War - says **When a child or a woman is captured, they become slaves by being captured, & the woman's previous marriage is immediately ended.**

Torture:

Quran 5:33 says that the "crime" of fighting against Muhammad can result in **crucifixion, cutting off their hands and feet on opposite sides, or exile.** Note crucifixion is designed to be a slow torture death

Quran 8:12 **God orders Muhammad to cut the necks and fingers of the disbelievers**

Sahih Al-Bukhari 4:52:261 **Muhammad's response when some men stole camels: he had their hands and feet cut off. Then he ordered for nails which were heated and passed over their eyes, and they were left in the rocky place. They asked for water, and nobody provided them with water**

History of Al-Tabari Vol 8 p 122-3 explains that the Jewish leader at Khaibar, Kinana, had a fire lit on his body to try to get him to give away the whereabouts of his money. He was then killed.

History of Al-Tabari Vol 8 p 95-7 **Umm Qirfah was an old woman and a leader of opposition to Muhammad. He had her different legs tied to two different camels which then pulled her body apart.**

Rape:

Quran 5:33 **Your females are for you to plough, so go to plough them as you please...**

Quran 23:1-6 says that men can have sex with wives or slaves

Sunan Abi Dawud 2141 (is sahih) **Muhammad says it is a serious sin to refuse to have sex with your husband. Sahih Muslim Book 16 Chapt. 20 describes it as illegal. Note that rebellious wives are to be beaten according to Quran 4:34.**

Sahih Al-Bukhari 6968: **If a virgin girl is forced into marriage because a man gets witnesses to lie that she consented to marry him, they are married, & "There is no punishment if he has sex with her", though the literal translation is actually: "There is no punishment if he tramples her"; (he tramples her = *yaṭā-ha*, يَطَأُهَا), indicating violence (implicitly sexual)**

History of Al-Tabari Vol 39 p 185 describes that after killing her father, brother, and husband, Muhammad had sex with Safiya of Khaibar, and that an armed guard was present in case she resisted – i.e. it was clearly a rape.
